**Concession Scheduling:** Nancie shared that there is a link on the new website to volunteer. Scheduling as of now is based on a team concept for sign-ups. If we move to a new sign up method, we could do individual sign ups. We discussed using both Time-Tap and I-volunteer. Another possibility is that each team will be assigned a certain number of slots per season. The number of slots assigned could be based on size of the team.
