**Concessions:** Sue will purchase food for the upcoming wrestling tournament on 12/7/19. We will purchase fruit, oatmeal, breakfast pizza, and bagels.

**Volunteers:** Nancie shared that volunteer sign up is going well for the winter session. She shared a few dates that need to be filled by board members for open/close volunteers.

**Logo:** Bob shared that we have sold \$14,131.00 in apparel since inception of squad locker in January of 2018.
