April Minutes: Sue motioned to accept the minutes for April and Nancie seconded. All other members approved.

Treasurer's Report: Our current balance is \$56,145.00 between our two accounts. Our cash on hand is \$54,309.00. Our credit card balance is \$3,085.00. \$1700.00 of this is being reimbursed from John Keib for the video equipment. One thousand dollars will be reimbursed to us for a hot chocolate machine that was purchased for the outdoor concession stand. The rest of the purchases were for the Lyndon concession stand to get that up and running. Amy made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and sue seconded it. All other members approved the motion.

Fund the Red Rams:

The Golf tournament planning is well under way. There are close to 30 teams signed up already. We are almost full. The most we can have is 36 teams. We are working on sponsors and have at least 20 so far. Eric made motion to give \$700.00 for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes at the golf tournament. Diane seconded it. All other board members approved. We discussed how the booster club will honor the football team from 1981. We may design a t-shirt, display pictures, and have the coach speak about the team. The captains will speak as well.

The mailing went out to alumni, families, and vendors. We have collected \$1200.00 so far. Amy will try and get an earlier date for the color run for next year.

All the video equipment has come in. We have very good professional equipment to record these games. The students under the guidance of Beth Quackenbush are working to plan and train in order to broadcast these games well. The board will continue to work with the district to get wifi in the press box.

We have made \$780.00 at our gear store so far this year.

Concession: Please continue to encourage customers to recycle cans and bottles. Please empty the grease tray at the end of the night. There will be a nets tournament in May.

Athletic Report: The field four scoreboard will be installed on Wednesday, May 3, 2018. The Lyndon concession stand has not been approved yet. Senior banquet planning is underway. John is ordering plaques. We will be scheduling a meeting soon to firm up details.

New Business: We will have elections on June 14th during our regular scheduled meeting. Nominations will be due by June 1st to Eric Moskow.

Diane made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Jackie seconded it. All other members approved this motion.
